To expand and develop the rural sector of India, HWC launched Project Srishtipath. To fulfill the objectives of rural India's development, HWC aims to open centers where the services like health, medical, nutrition, legal, child development programs, etc., will be provided.

PROJECT SHELTER

HWC established 'Project Shelter' to help put a roof over the maximum number of heads. We are not just constructing a shelter; we are doing much more than that by building entire communities, complete with town halls, roads, electricity, wells, sewage systems, and clean drinking water.



PROJECT BLUESHOWER

This Project is a step forward to save this blue planet by conserving water and water resources. We believe in using technical advancements to reserve depleting water resources and reuse water to avoid wastage.

Project BLUESHOWER conserves water by promoting rainwater harvesting systems, building wells, water tanks, and other such systems.

We help track your missing family members and reunite families using advanced technology swiftly. We set up a tracking system to hold details and all other particulars of the lost people and their photographs.



ERRS

Emergency Rapid Relief Squad (ERRS) is an independent vertical under the umbrella of the Humanity Welfare Council. ERRS values the interests of impoverished people worst hit by both natural and unnatural disasters, a system catering to all the needs in the shortest possible time in a disaster-hit area.

Our Work

1. The Humanity Welfare Council conducted a charitable event on 15.09.2018. The event was **Project Uphaar**, an initiative of the HWC to encourage people to donate, donating to the causes you care about. Millions of people give to charity regularly to support causes they believe in and the positive effect it has on their own lives.



To promote Project Uphaar, we donated Foods Items to the poor people who live in slum areas of Delhi. We distributed the following items to people in slum areas of the JJ colony:

- 284 kg of Wheat Flour
 - 187 Kg of Dal
 - 83 Kg of Chawal
2. We opened a portable office in Bundelkhand as part of the inauguration of **Project Srishtipath** on 18.04.2019. We help rural people with essential registrations like Aadhaar Card, Gas Connections, etc.



SrishtiPath Kendra (Portable Office) is a social hub center where we have planned to provide health facilities (including traditional Indian medicine), educational facilities (including adult and digital education), trading and marketing of rural products, skill development for rural youth, employment, information and communication facilities, clean water, food security, legal Aid, orphan and old age home, village tourism, environment conservation (including the revival of water bodies), etc. under one roof.

During the Inauguration event, we Conducted a seminar to impart awareness to the public about their rights, how they can trade their handmade products and the benefits of keeping our surroundings neat and clean. Apart from that, we conducted free dental check-ups & Basic check-ups. After the Check-up, we distributed free medicines to patients suffering from Fever, Dental Decay, Cough, etc.

3. As a part of Project Phulwari, we distributed the following items to many AWCs (Anganwadi Centres) on 22.07.2019 & 13.08.2019:

- Colour books
- Alphabet books
- Drawing Books
- Pencils & slates



4. We distributed food to slum areas of Delhi NCR as a part of **Project Uphaar** on 30.08.2019, 1.12.2019, 10.01.2020, 14.01.2020, 05.03.2020 and 16.03.2020



5. In the flooded region of Bihar, we extended help to hundreds of families by providing food in the remotest areas. We offered almost 1200 meals daily. In addition, our squad supported 1410 families by providing ration supplies. With this compassion act, ERRS initiated small steps towards a significant change.



6. **ERRS** has supported 1250 families in **Kerala, Assam, and Mumbai** during floods. The ration and first aid kits were delivered to remote areas devastated by floods.



7. Unimaginable destruction was caused by **Cyclone Fani**, which ravaged Puri. With no electricity and a complete shutdown of public transportation, it was difficult to reach the devastated areas of Puri. However, our squad made it through and provided food and other ration supplies in this devastated region.



8. Supported 45,500 families during **COVID-19** by starting **Covid Relief fund**. Distributed 3 ply masks to the needy people during the first wave of Covid-19.



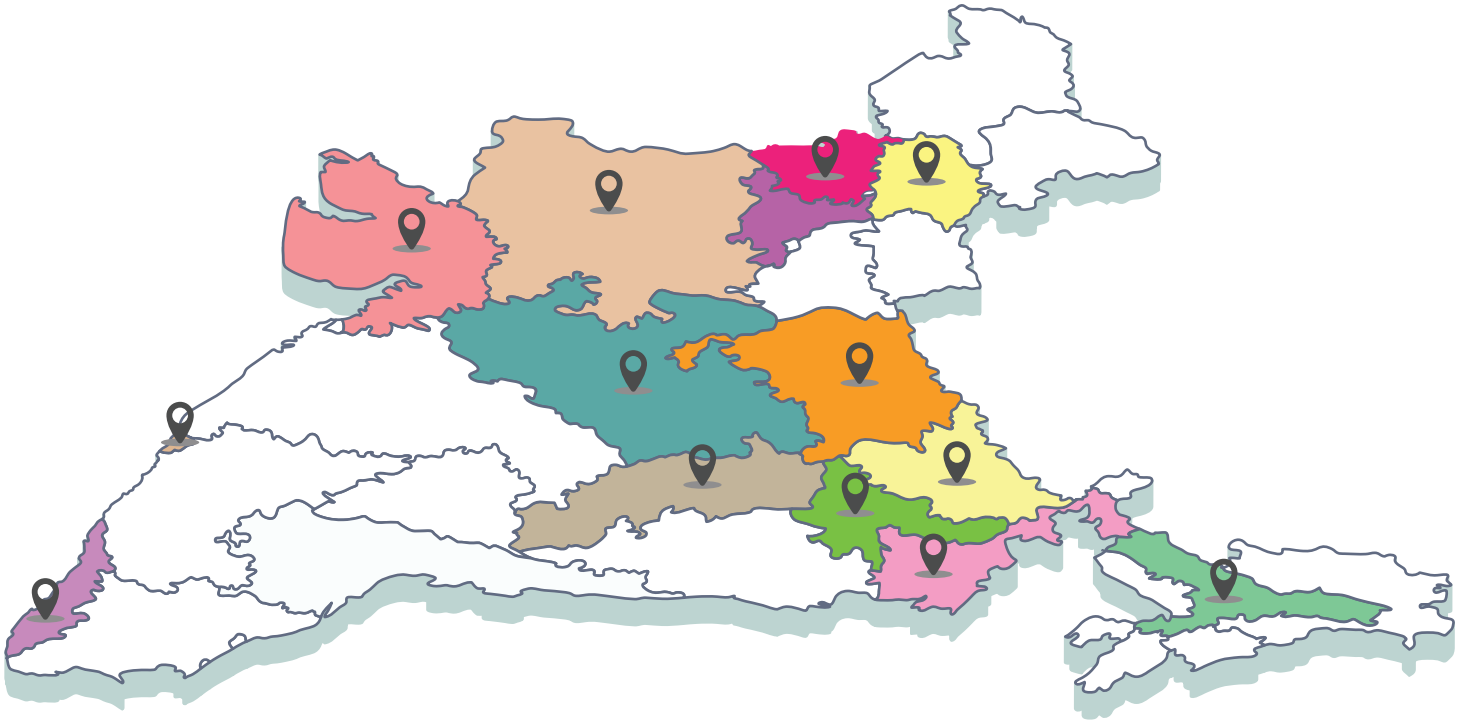
